

## CHAPTER 65

### STOP OR YIELD REQUIRED

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65.03 Yield Required

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**65.01 STOP REQUIRED.** Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following:

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Bailey Drive. Vehicles traveling west on Bailey Drive shall stop at Bingham Avenue;
2. Broadway Street. Vehicles traveling on Broadway Street shall stop at Bingham Avenue;
3. Pesch Street. Vehicles traveling on Pesch Street shall stop at Bingham Avenue;
4. Elizabeth Avenue. Vehicles traveling on Elizabeth Avenue shall stop at Main Street;
5. Patton Street. Vehicles traveling west on Patton Street shall stop at Bingham Avenue;
6. Hiams Avenue. Vehicles traveling south on Hiams Avenue shall stop at Bingham Avenue.

**65.02 FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.** Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated four-way stop intersections:

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Intersection of Bingham Avenue and Main Street.

**65.03 YIELD REQUIRED.** Every driver of a vehicle shall yield in accordance with the following:

*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)*

1. Duffy Street. Vehicles traveling west on Duffy Street shall yield at Bingham Avenue.

**65.04 STOP BEFORE CROSSING SIDEWALK.** The driver of a vehicle emerging from a private roadway, alley, driveway, or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto the sidewalk area and thereafter shall

proceed into the sidewalk area only when able to do so without danger to pedestrian traffic and shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicular traffic on the street into which the vehicle is entering.

**65.05 STOP WHEN TRAFFIC IS OBSTRUCTED.** Notwithstanding any traffic control signal indication to proceed, no driver shall enter an intersection or a marked crosswalk unless there is sufficient space on the other side of the intersection or crosswalk to accommodate the vehicle.

**65.06 YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS IN CROSSWALKS.** Where traffic control signals are not in place or in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, slowing down or stopping, if need be, to yield to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within any marked crosswalk or within any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection.
